## HOW TO SIGN UP ON THE E-LEARNING PLATFORM

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In order to use the system, it is necessary to register and login.

Registration is very simple and intuitive: just click on the little icon at the top right of the page and enter the required information (mandatory information are first name, surname, language in which to follow the courses, e-mail and password, optional phone number), accept the privacy statement and check the box "I am not a robot".

It is important to keep in mind that once a language for taking courses has been selected, it will not be possible to change the preference.

#### HOW TO TAKE A COURSE



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Logged-in users can enter the course section and start following the modules they wish.

In this section it is possible to visualize all the courses being followed, those completed, those in progress and those not yet started. The courses will only be visible in the language chosen during registration. The progress bar for each single course will show the completion status. To view the program, just click on each module and open the information about the topics covered, the organization responsible for creating the course, the hours of teaching and the EQF level. In addition, it will be possible to read the assessment methods, the learning outcomes and the content of the learning activities. The description is visible in the language selected during registration.
